Since its foundation the club has grown into a very successful club, still catering for young people of all ages. The club not only operates in Battle but now also provides opportunities for the young people of Hastings & St Leonard's. In addition the club attracts players for surrounding villages and as Tunbridge Wells.

The past year has seen the start of a new era for the club when we moved into premises based at Claverham Community Sports College. The club is an official partner club working along side Claverham to develop the sport both within Claverham, other local schools and the wider community



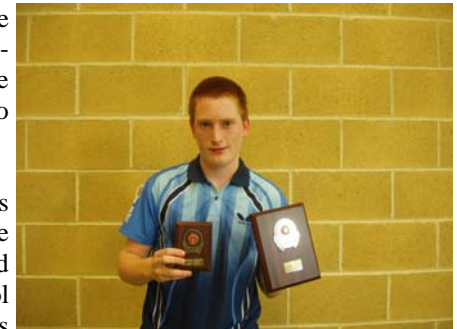
The club is registered with the English Table Tennis Association, we are an ETTA Premier Club, the Sussex County TTA and works closely with Rother District Councils Sports Development Unit as well as the Hastings & Rother Schools Sports Partnership to promote the sport within Rother. We also founded and organise the Battle & District Junior Table Tennis League.

At Battle Table Tennis Club we believe in offering all our young players the opportunity to flourish, regardless of standard or ability. Players are offered opportunities to be coached, play in teams, work towards awards and of course have fun as well. As players progress, opportunities to play at Regional and National level are provided through the National Cadet and Junior Leagues. Many players, past and present, have gained National Rankings at U-13, U-15 and U-18 levels. We firmly believe in 'Opportunity for All'.

All coaching and sessions are led by a fully qualified, insured, ETTA Coach with leaders assisting from time to time, who are carefully selected to ensure our young members are safe and secure. The club is also working towards 'Club Mark' a Sports England Certification for child friendly and safe clubs.

The club has also been certified by Rother District Council as a child friendly and safe club.

As well as valuable support from Claverham Community Sports College the club has received much appreciated support from Rother District Councils' Sports Development Department, The High Street Dental Practice based in Robertsbridge who supported our schools league. Support in the form of equipment and promotional materials have also come from Tees Sports / Butterfly who are official suppliers to the club.



Rother District Council's Sports Development Unit also provide funding from time to time and have provided support for school sessions, Taster Days as well as coaching courses and other events. This year they are to provide support for young volunteers to gain leadership skills in sport.

Its easy to join us and become part of the 'Table Tennis Family'. Just check out our session times overleaf. You are welcome to just turn up on the day, however, its always nice to know in advance that you are coming, so that we may arrange for someone to welcome you in person. Your child will be personally welcomed by a club official who will introduce them to the club. They will be allocated a 'buddie' who will look after them during their first session, unless they already have a friend who attends the club. Parents are always welcome to stay and watch if they wish, but please do remember some children hate their parents watching them!!
