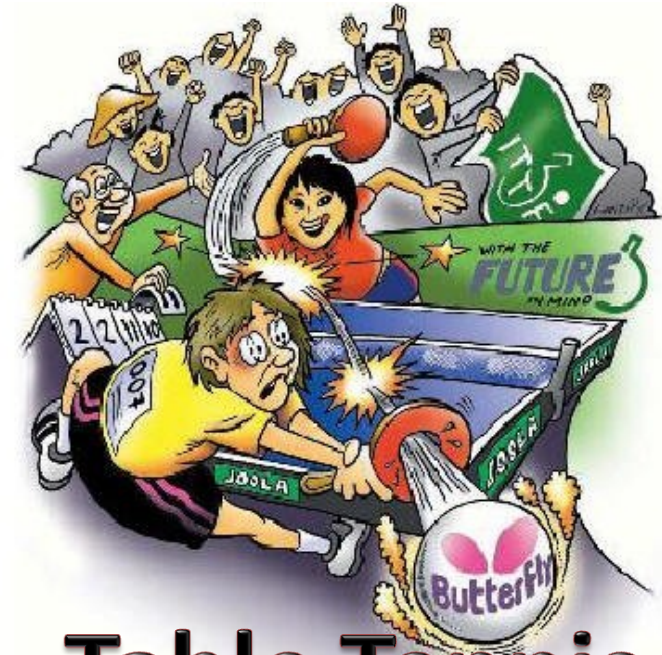

Introduction.....

Our Table Tennis Leadership Awards are designed for young people to develop valuable leadership skills as well as providing a chance to experience the opportunities that are available within the sport apart from just being a player.

There are two award levels, Primary and Junior, with the Junior Award incorporating elements of the ETTA Networker Award and the ETTA Junior Umpires Award. The awards can also be of extreme value for those working toward a GCSE in PE.

The awards are designed to be taken as part of a student's normal sessions, however occasionally it may be necessary to attend a special session to complete certain parts of the award. This is all part of the experience that the award is designed to provide to those taking part. Where this is likely to be a problem we will attempt to find an alternative way for a student to complete these sections of the award, however, please be aware that this may not always be possible.



Once an award has been completed students will be presented with a certificate with those completing the Junior Award becoming official Academy Table Tennis Leaders.

How to Take Part

To get involved is easy. Just ask your coach or contact the academy direct. We will then send you a pack and information on how to go about starting an award. The Primary Table Tennis Leaders Award is open to Years 5 & 6, whilst the Junior Award is open to those in Years 7 - 11.

If you are undertaking GCSE PE you may wish to let your PE teacher aware that you are taking this award, It could be that some of the work you undertake within the award could count towards your course work! It may also count towards any other award you may be taking, including the Junior Sports Leaders Award and Community Sports Leaders Award.

The Awards.....

Primary Table Tennis Leaders Award

This award is open to pupils in Years 5 & 6. You will need to complete the following tasks:-

- Learn about the equipment needed to play the game.
- Learn some basic rules of table tennis
- Learn the names of the basic strokes & demonstrate at least 2 of your choice.
- Umpire two complete matches
- Teach some skills to some Year 3-4 pupils
- Organise the Table Tennis Ladder with a partner
- Organise a competition.

Junior Table Tennis Leaders Award

- Learn the basic laws of table tennis
- Learn about the equipment needed to play the game
- Understand the basic strokes and demonstrate at least 3 of your choice
- Umpire two Junior League Matches
- Complete the Junior Umpires Award Paper
- Assist a coach with some coaching including teaching a basic stroke to a group of 4 players
- Organise a session using the ETTA Competitions Ladder
- Organise a small tournament with at least 8 players being involved.
- Write a match report for a web site including taking a photo to go with the report.
- Helping out, as a volunteer at 4 sessions as agreed with the coach.
- Design a poster promoting either the sport or your school club/club.
- Assist at an event .

This award can be completed in your own time and you will get the chance to discuss a plan with your coach. Your coach will also be able to help you with any problems you might experience in taking parts of the award. Once you have completed you will become an official Academy Table Tennis Leader and be recommended for a higher level award.
